Worship Ministry Team (WMT)

The Worship Ministry Team meets once a month to discuss and oversee both long and short term worship topics. They assist with planning special services and events within the congregation. Reps from the elders, deacons, sound booth, organ/piano, praise band, and praise singers along with other individuals comprise this team.

Praise Team

The praise band leads the congregation in worship through song usually twice a month. They utilize guitars, drums, piano, and voices as they play primarily contemporary songs, but can also play traditional hymns.

Praise Singers

The praise singers use their voices in leading the North Holland congregation in song. Different singers participate on a rotating basis. They lead worship two or three times a month. Sometimes some of the praise singers will add their voices to the praise band.

Sound Booth

Their responsibilities include microphones, recording of the services, any projections on the screen, videos, and other technological aspects to the worship service.
